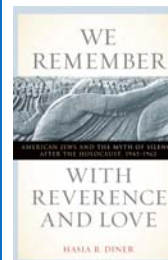

JTS Lecture with Sharon Mintz January 12, 2010 “Jewish Art”

The Ketubbah—an integral part of Jewish weddings for centuries and represent a magnificent expression of the tradition of Jewish Art. This lecture will explore the splendid art of the Ketubbah and the fascinating social and historical context which surrounded their production. Sharon Mintz is the curator of Jewish art at the Jewish Theological Seminary Library. JTS owns the largest collection of Judaica in the United States. Book Talk with Hassia Diner February 9, 2010 “We Remember with Reverence and Love” *American Jews and the Myth of Silence after the Holocaust, 1945-1962*



It has become an accepted truth: after World War II, American Jews chose to be silent about the mass murder of millions at the hands of the Nazis. Hassia Diner shows this assumption of silence to be categorically false. In her book, Diner shows a rich and incredibly varied trove of remembrances.
